

# AMERISAFE FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

---

## SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

---

**AWARD: \$2,000 – 2-year program or \$4,000 – 4-year program**

Each year, subject to availability of funds, one scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior who is a child, stepchild, grandchild or legal guardian of a full-time employee, excluding those on a temporary basis, of AMERISAFE. The scholarship will be \$500/semester. The employee must be employed with AMERISAFE for one year and be in good standing at the time of qualification. The student may not be a child, stepchild, grandchild or legal guardian of an AMERISAFE Executive or Board Member. This student must be pursuing a college degree, in either a 2 or 4-year program, beginning in the Fall following their graduation. They must also have maintained a 3.0 GPA. This scholarship may be renewed each semester for up to two (2) years for a 2-year degree and four (4) years for a 4-year degree, provided renewal requirements are met.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

---

1. High School Transcript – minimum 3.0 GPA
2. Letter of recommendation from faculty or staff of enrolled high school (member of academic organization for home school students)
3. Community service, leadership roles and extra-curricular activities
4. Awards and recognitions
5. 500-word essay to demonstrate personal drive and sense of purpose

---

## RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

---

1. Maintain a minimum overall GPA of 3.0
2. Renewable for 8 undergraduate semesters, or 12 undergraduate quarters, or a bachelor's degree, whichever comes first
3. Maintain good standing in the university or college
4. Earn enough credit hours to be considered full-time student

Applications must be submitted by **March 17, 2024**. The recipient will be announced at a graduation related event.
